

SNOWMAN

Material

1 Pair of 3mm (UK11) Needles
White DK Wool
Black DK Wool
Contrast Wool for Scarf
Red or Orange for Nose felt optional
Green for Holly felt optional
Toy stuffing

Body and Head

With white cast on 26 stitches and stocking stitch for 24 rows

Shape Head Row

Knit 5 knit 2 tog knit 12 knit 2tog knit 5(24sts)

Stocking stitch 11 rows

Knit 2 tog to the end (12sts)

Break yarn leave long end. Thread through stitches on needle draw up tightly and fasten off for top of head.

Hat

With black cast on 20stitches and stocking stitch 4 rows

1st Decrease Row K 2 (K2tog K3) 3 times K 2tog K1 (16sts) Stocking Stitch 3 rows.

2nd Decrease Row K1 (K2tog K2) 3 times K2tog K1 (12sts) Stocking Stitch 3 rows.

3rd Decrease Row (K1 K2tog) 4 times (8sts) Stocking Stitch 2 rows

K2tog to end, break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread through stitches on needle and draw up tightly

And fasten off. Join side edges of hat.

Scarf

With a coloured wool cast on 36 sts and K3 rows, cast off.

To Make Up.

Join side edges working down from gathered top edge of head. To make the head work a gathering thread through every stitch on head shape row, draw up and stuff head.

Position and sew on the hat and scarf. Using red felt to make a nose and sew onto the head.

Embroider black eyes, black buttons. Decorate the head if wanted holly and berry.

Using wool that matches the scarf, work a gathering thread through the base edge of the snowman's body, draw up when chocolate is inside.
